Sculpture Features:



- One bud and two flowers in raspberry-pink
- 16 leaves in light mint green
- Hand-painted origami ruby-throated hummingbird attached to one flower
- Two uncoiling fiddleheads
- Black pot with tiny pebbles
- Easy to mount! Comes with a non-destructive, stick-on wall hook.
- Neutral colors blend with any décor

- Limited to 42 sculptures. Each sculpture is signed, dated and

numbered by the artist.

Origami Bonsai sculptures are made by hand entirely from paper. Leaves and flowers are made from hand painted squares of paper using the origami technique (origami means "fold-paper" in Japanese). Stems and fiddleheads are made from pieces of newsprint using the makigami technique (makigami means "roll-paper" n Japanese). You can find more information on this art form at:
